

Luca Zoss is awarded a diploma at the WorldSkills 2013 Competitions!

The WorldSkills Competitions 2013 took place in Leipzig (Germany) from July 2nd to 7th, 2013. This major vocational training event, which attracted over 200'000 visitors, brought together the finest young professionals in skilled trades and technologies from all over the world, who competed with each other during the four days of competition.

The Swiss delegation consisted of 39 candidates, representing 37 different trades.

Luca Zoss (Gilgen Door Systems AG) and his team mate Marco Hofer (Fritz Studer AG) vied for a top classification among the large number of participants from 32 nations in the field of automation engineering.

The Swiss team of automation engineers has succeeded in asserting themselves against the strong competition, being awarded a diploma with the distinction „Medal for Excellence“.
